MULTI- FUNCTIONAL SPACE

LabCultural is a living space dedicated to artistic creation, collaboration and transformation through art. A place where music, visual arts, performing arts and critical thinking intersect to generate community and new forms of creative dialogue. Located in Barcelona, LabCultural functions as a space for creation, encounter and co-living, hosting artistic processes, residencies, exhibitions, workshops and culture-live proposals in an intimate and human-scale format.

EXHIBITION SPACE • VISUAL ARTS



The exhibition space at LabCultural hosts contemporary visual art practices, understood as open and situated processes. Each exhibition is conceived as a sensitive and reflective experience that engages with the space, the context and the community, going beyond traditional exhibition formats.

LIVE CULTURE MUSIC · PERFORMING ARTS ·



LabCultural is an intimate stage for live culture proposals. Music, dance, performance, poetry and hybrid practices coexist in a close and caring setting that prioritises presence, listening and encounter between artists, space and audiences.



WORKSHOPS CREATION · THOUGHT · MEDIATION ·

LabCultural hosts workshops and learning processes led by artists and facilitators who understand art and as tools for awareness, healing and social transformation. The workshops take place in a safe and intimate environment, addressing areas such as voice liberation, circles, sexuality, women's and dissident rights, and art therapy.





ARTISTIC RESIDENCIES

RESIDENCE ACTIVITIES

Residencies at LabCultural are designed as open investigational periods where artists can:

- Develop experimental work in sound, visual arts, performance and hybrid media
- Receive Mentoring and process accompaniment
- Test interactions between disciplines and artistic approaches
- Engage with local audiences through open rehearsals, sharings, informal viewings or public outcomes
 - Collaborate with other residents in shared or overlapping processes

This framework is a process-oriented approach that does not require predefined outputs; instead, it fosters methodological experimentation and iterative development over fixed outcomes.



CONTEXT ENVIRONMENT



The environment is especially suited to artists and creative practitioners who value independence practice, dialogue, reflection, and process-oriented work.

Residents at LabCultural benefit from:

- A well-connected urban context in Barcelona
- Daily access to the workspace and equipment
- Shared cultural programming and informal exchange with local artistic networks
- A residential room integrated into the co-living environment
 - Accès to terrace space
- A supportive and responsive host organisation

LIVING SPACE

LabCultural offers a shared living environment with a dedicated bedroom for residents, integrated in the upper part of the creative space. This co-living setting supports immersive artistic processes, daily exchange and close interaction between residents, hosts and the local artistic community.



Shared spaces:

Creative workspace, kitchen, dining area, terrace, bathroom.

Private space:

Double bedroom for residents.
